TUITION & FEES

REGISTRATON: \$75 (Waived for TEA/Foster Care

applicants)

TUITION PAYMENTS:

- Tuition is charged weekly—regardless of attendance or weather closures.
- Pay in advance each week.
- Payment options: Auto Draft, Card at front desk, or MyProcare app.
- Declined cards = \$10 late fee + balance due before return.
- LSS accepts debit/credit cards and bank draft only.

WEEKLY TUITION RATES: PART-TIME CARE:

- Infants (6 wks 18 mo): \$210
- Toddlers (18 mo 3 yrs): \$210
- Preschool (3 & 4 yrs): \$200
- School Age (5+): \$190
- Aftercare Only: \$80

- 3+ days/week = prorated rate
- 1 day/week = \$35 drop-in rate

STATE VOUCHER

- Rates set by State.
- Partial voucher families follow same payment schedule as self-pay.

OCCASIONAL CHARGES:

- Late Pick-Up After Closing: \$1/min per child
- Late Pick-Up for Sickness/Misbehavior: \$10/hr (after 1st hour)
- Late Payment Fee: \$10/week until paid
- Bounced Check: \$25 + late fees
- Arrival after 9:50 am: Not accepted

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What are your school hours?

A: We are open from 6:30am - 6:00pm Monday - Friday.

Q: Do you provide meals?

A: Yes—We follow CACFP guidelines to serve balanced meals with whole grains, lean proteins, fruits, veggies, and milk. Menus are posted weekly online, on the Procare App and in our lobby. We gladly accommodate allergies—just let our staff know.

Q: Do I need to buy school supplies?

A: No—all supplies are provided.

Q: What ages do you serve?

A: Infants (6 weeks) through 2nd grade, plus before/after school and summer care.

Q: Do you have uniform requirements?

A: Uniforms are not required! At Little Scholars, we encourage comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing that lets kids play and learn with ease. Please label all clothing and belongings, keep two extra outfits at school, and bring six diapers or pull-ups daily if needed. Safe shoes only—no long dresses, boots, or flip-flops. Personal items should stay home unless it's Show & Tell day.
